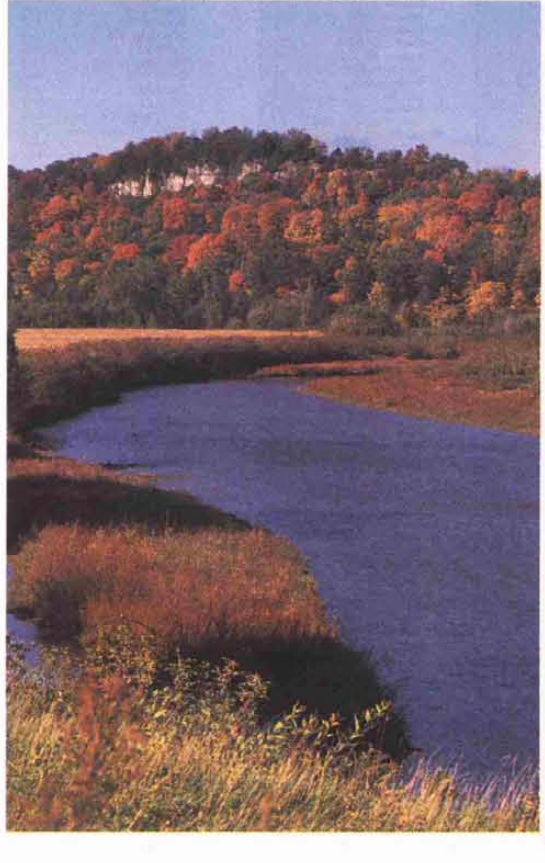

RIVER BLUFFS SCENIC BYWAY

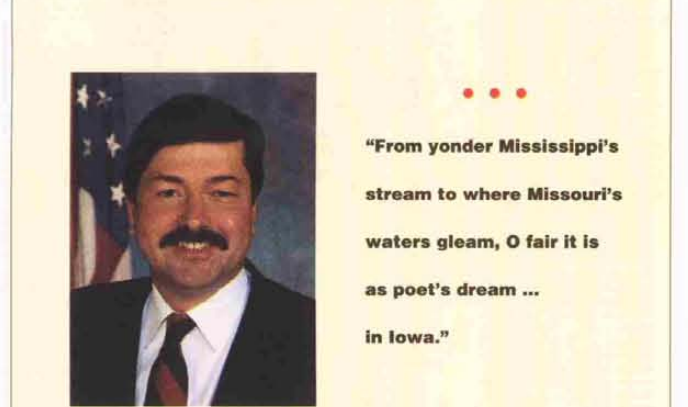

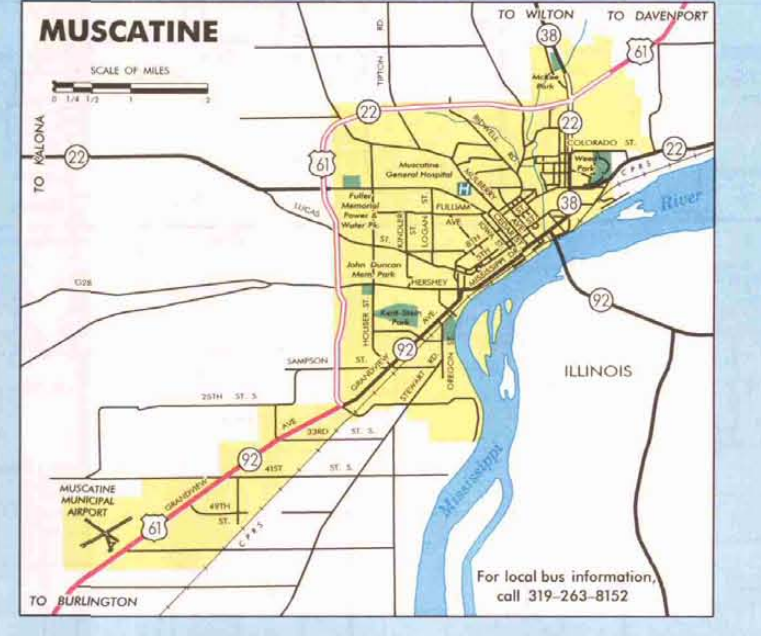

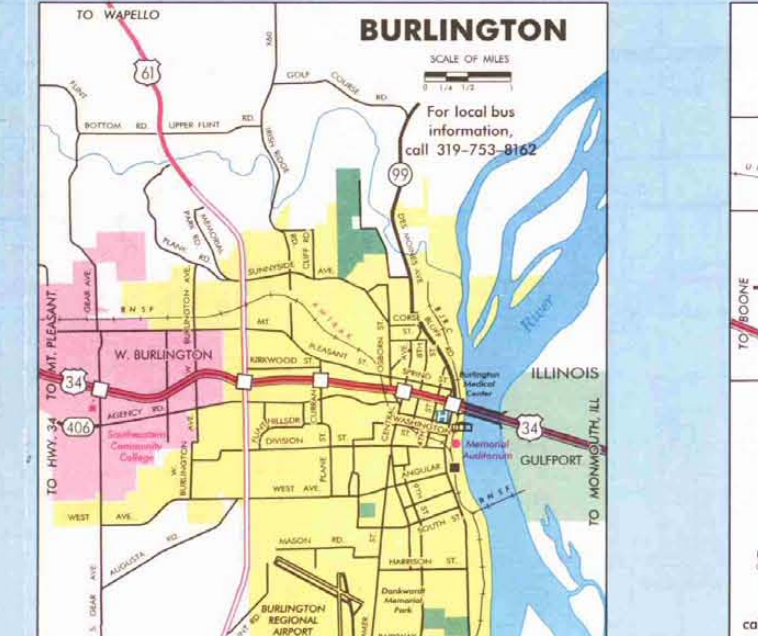
DETOUR MAP

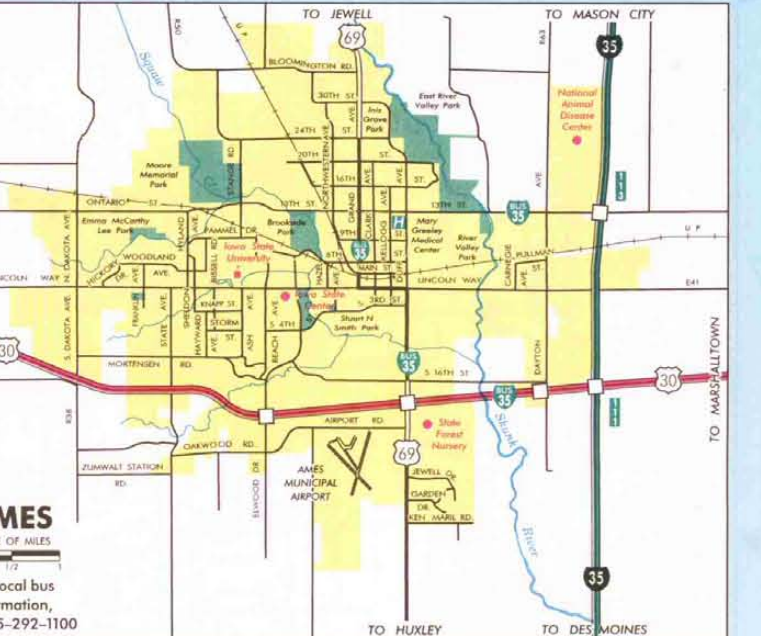
Table showing detour routes for various highways, including highway numbers, detour routes, and distances.

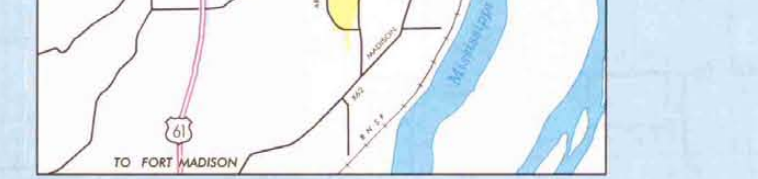

MILEPOSTS

Mileposts, installed at one-mile intervals along Iowa's rural interstate Highways and some primary highway routes, aid motorists and traffic officers in accurately locating and reporting accidents or emergencies.

BIKERS

BICYCLISTS share Iowa's roadways with other vehicles. They have all the same rights and duties as drivers of motor vehicles. A head lamp and rear reflector are required for night operation...

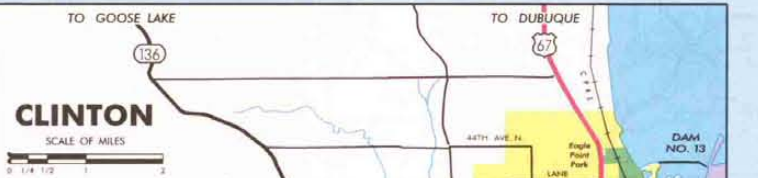
